Lid it! This exhibition reflects on Melbourne's famous '9 by 5' exhibition at Tom Roberts's Studio in Melbourne, August 1889, artworks were painted on recycled cigar lids in.

Lid it! is a group exhibition of artworks created on recycled lids paying homage to the past while exploring the future. Lid it! is an artist run initiative by Fern Smith held at her art studio in August.

You are welcome to enter as many recycled lid artworks as you would like. There is a fee of \$10 entry which includes one artwork. There is a fee of \$5 per additional artwork. For example, two artworks will be \$15 entry and if you enter 5 artworks it is \$30 for entry

- Open entry to all creative minded people (you do not need to be a professional artist and if under the age of 18 years you will need a parent or legal guardian to *co-sign* your application)
- No works that are **R** rated will be exhibited as it is an open exhibition for all ages clarification <http://www.classification.gov.au/Guidelines/Pages/G.aspx>
- Sale of artwork there is 10% commission fee
- Paid deposit before exhibition unless discussed and replied in writing by Fern Smith
- Exhibition opening hours 19th August to 27th August 10.30am to 5 pm
- Your work being used for promotional purposes for the week leading into the exhibition to one week after the exhibition (12 August -7th September 2017). (From Fernartz news website, press release, Arts Hub call out, fernartz social media) If your work is used your name will be attributed to the work. Photographs will also be taken at the opening as a representation of the exhibition your work then may not be attributed if not clearly identified.
- Artists agree to promote the exhibition and their work in the exhibition via social media and send Fernartz a link for evaluation
- Fernartz holds no responsibility of a visitor photographing your work especially at the opening, there will be a copyright information available for visitors to hopefully abide by.
